Liberation **educates, agitates** and **organises** the fight against **imperialism** and the legacies of colonialism. **Democracy, human rights, peace and social justice** are central to our goals.

We reject **foreign interventionism** and **militarism**. We support **popular sovereignty**. Liberation believes **international solidarity** and **co-operation** are the means to make a better world.

Our main focus is **Britain's former colonies** and the Anglo-American sphere of influence.

Liberation organises **public meetings** to **raise awareness** of current events and **stimulate action**.

We run **seminars, webinars** and other educational activities.

We work with **UK parliamentarians** to influence UK foreign policy and **engage at an international level** through the UN and ILO.

We publish a **quarterly journal**, and comment and analysis on relevant matters on our website.

OUR HISTORY

Liberation is **one of the UK's oldest human rights organisations**, founded in 1954 as the Movement for Colonial Freedom. For more than half a century we campaigned alongside other anti-imperialist forces, to rid the world of colonialism.

In 1970 our name changed to **Liberation**, **an organisation that today opposes new forms of imperialism, or "neo-colonialism"**, intervening and laying waste to the global south, perpetuating economic exploitation, inequality and racism. Our fight continues!

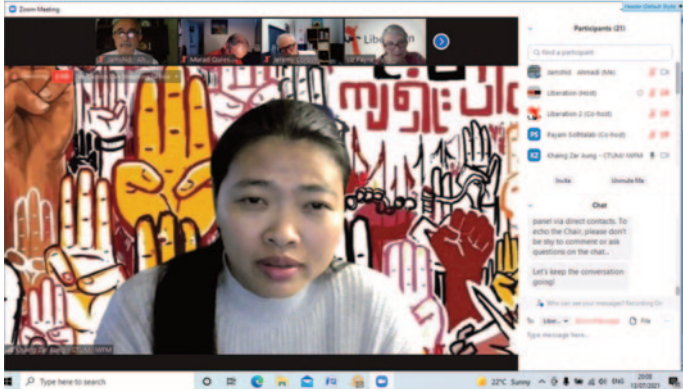
JOIN US!

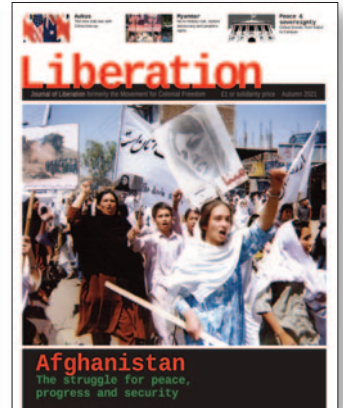
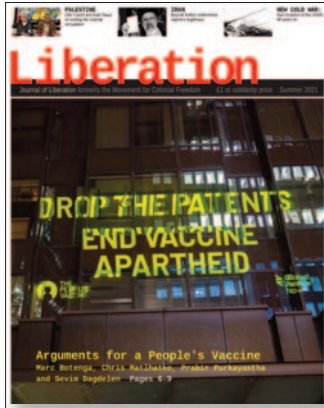
